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THE INDIANA COAL INDUSTRY

Coal is of vital importance to the state's economy, not only as a valuable commodity in its own right, but also in that it powers nearly all facets of the state's economy. The U.S. Department of Energy reports that 60.3 million tons of coal were consumed in the state during 1993, ranking the state second in the nation in coal consumption. The federal agency reports that Indiana produced 29.3 million tons of bituminous coal during 1993, ranking the state tenth nationally and reflecting a 3.8 percent decrease from 1992. Coal is currently produced by 26 companies (including subcontractors) at 58 mines in the state with a total of 89 pits and underground operations. These include six active and idle underground mines in five counties (Greene, Knox, Sullivan, Vanderburgh, and Gibson) and 52 active and idle surface mines in 13 counties (Clay, Daviess, Dubois, Gibson, Greene, Knox, Martin, Owen, Pike, Spencer, Sullivan, Vigo, and Warrick), all located in southwestern Indiana (fig. 1). The largest consumers of Indiana coal are coal-fired electric generating stations which consume 85.3 percent of the coal produced in Indiana. Industry consumes another 12.8 percent, and the rest is used by residential, commercial, and coking plant consumers. Indiana has abundant recoverable coal reserves, estimated at 1.9 billion short tons of surface reserves and 15.9 billion short tons of underground reserves for a total of 17.8 billion short tons of recoverable coal reserves, based on 80 percent recoverability for surface mines and 50 percent recoverability for underground mines. The Mine Safety and Health Administration reported an average of 2,948 workers employed by Indiana coal mines during 1993.

Pressure on electric power companies due to the implementation of parts of the Federal 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments will undoubtedly lead to increased importation into Indiana of low-sulfur coal. This may lead to decreased production from Indiana coal mines and to more intense use of Indiana low-sulfur coals. Several initiatives are underway in the state to encourage the continued use of Indiana coal, including several projects partially funded by the U.S. Department of Energy under the Clean Coal Technology Program. The Indiana Geological Survey is contributing to the effort with studies by the Energy Resources Section, funded in part by the Indiana Department of Commerce, to help coal companies locate additional low-sulfur coal reserves, and with studies by the Mineral Resources Section to locate sources of crushed stone resources suitable for use as scrubber stone near coal-fired electric power plants. The long-term outlook for Indiana coal production is more optimistic as additional scrubbers are added to electric power plants and newer technologies are put into use during later phases of the Federal Clean Air Act Amendments. Those interested in Indiana coal quality may wish to order a copy of the Indiana Geological Survey publication, *The Quality of Indiana's Coal Resources* (Hasenmueller, 1994). Methodology

In compiling this directory, mailing lists were acquired from several different state and federal agencies including the Mine Safety and Health Administration, the U.S. Department of Energy, and the Indiana Bureau of Mines and Mining Safety. In addition, mining permit information was acquired through the Indiana Department of Natural Resources, Division of Reclamation. A mail canvass was sent to all companies known to be operating in the state and to all companies listed in the last directory to update existing information. Mine sites listed in the previous directory and those identified as currently active were visited by Penny Alano to identify geologic information and exact locations. Maps of active and abandoned areas were completed and digitized by Penny Alano. The format of the publication is much the same as that of the previous directory (Hasenmueller, 1991).

Explanation of Listings

Index 1. Each listing in Index 1 includes as much of the following information, in this order, as could be acquired: company name, (subcontractor), mine name, coal seams mined, mine office designation if applicable, address, city, state, and zip code, mine officers and their titles, mine telephone and fax numbers, type of mine, locality in relation to geographic features, geologic quadrangle in which active mining is occurring, congressional land survey for the mine office, remarks concerning the operation, pit names, and coal seams mined at each pit. If no telephone number is listed, there is either no telephone at the mine or the company did not want the number listed; contact with the company can be made through the regional offices listed in Index 2. Operations are arranged alphabetically by company. Mines or pits currently idle are indicated with an asterisk (*). Coal seams named are those in use by the Indiana Geological Survey. A stratigraphic listing of coal seams in Indiana is shown in figure 2. A complete explanation of coal seams can be found in the Indiana Geological Survey publication, Bulletin 59 (Shaver, and others, 1986). The Survey's Preliminary Coal Maps were used as the main reference for this publication.

Maps illustrate active and abandoned mine areas for each county. Listings are keyed to the maps using a state-assigned county number and a number assigned to each listing. A legend of applicable symbols accompanies each map. In most instances mine offices within one mile of a mine are not indicated on the maps. Mined areas abandoned prior to 1983 were compiled by the Indiana Geological Survey from company maps or aerial photographs. Areas abandoned after 1983 were compiled from sketches made on 1:24000 US Geological Survey quadrangle maps by the Indiana Geological Survey during a 1994 field study for this directory. This may not be a complete representation of the abandoned mine areas in the counties shown as information about areas mined between 1983 and 1994 may have been unavailable and therefore not illustrated on these maps.

Index 2. This index is a listing of regional corporate offices of companies with mines in Indiana, as well as subcontractors listed in Index 1. Each listing includes the following information, in this order: company name, corporate address, city, state, zip code, officers, telephone, and fax. Accompanying each listing is an index of mines and pits owned by that company and a designation of active or idle status. The number is the same as that used in Index 1.

Index 3. Index 3 is an alphabetical listing of all mines and pits in the state. The county of operation is listed in addition to the identification number used in Index 1. Idle mines or pits are indicated with an asterisk (*).

Index 4. Each listing in this index includes the following information: coal seam mined, county where the seam is mined, and the mine number as assigned in Index 1. Coal seams are arranged stratigraphically. An asterisk (*) indicates idle mines or pits.

Directories contain rapidly changing information. An effort was made to make this directory as current and accurate as possible. However, if you discover an error or if a change in a listing is necessary, please notify the Indiana Geological Survey.

Map of Indiana showing coal-bearing area, counties producing coal in 1994, and locations of coal-fired electric generating stations.

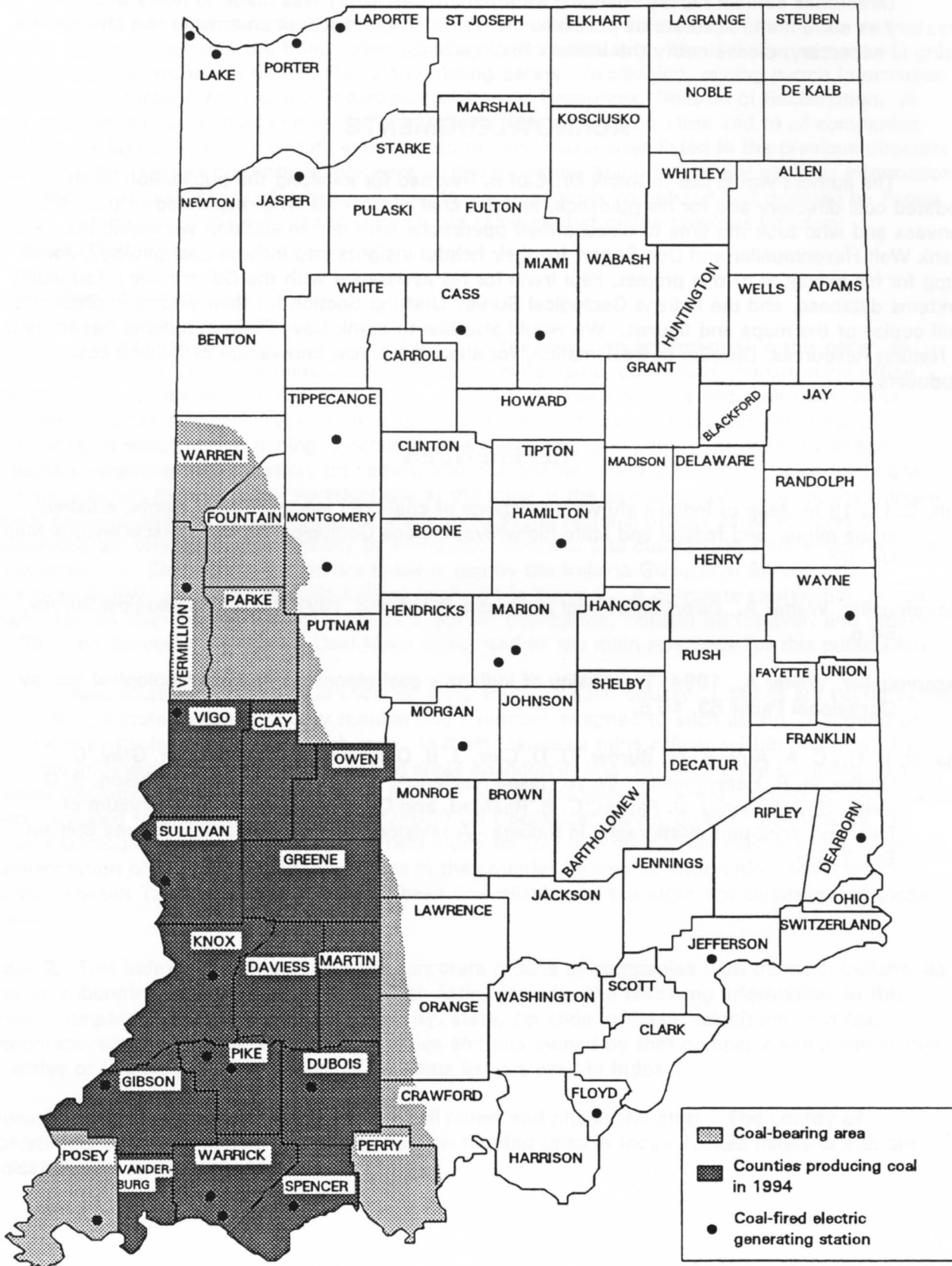
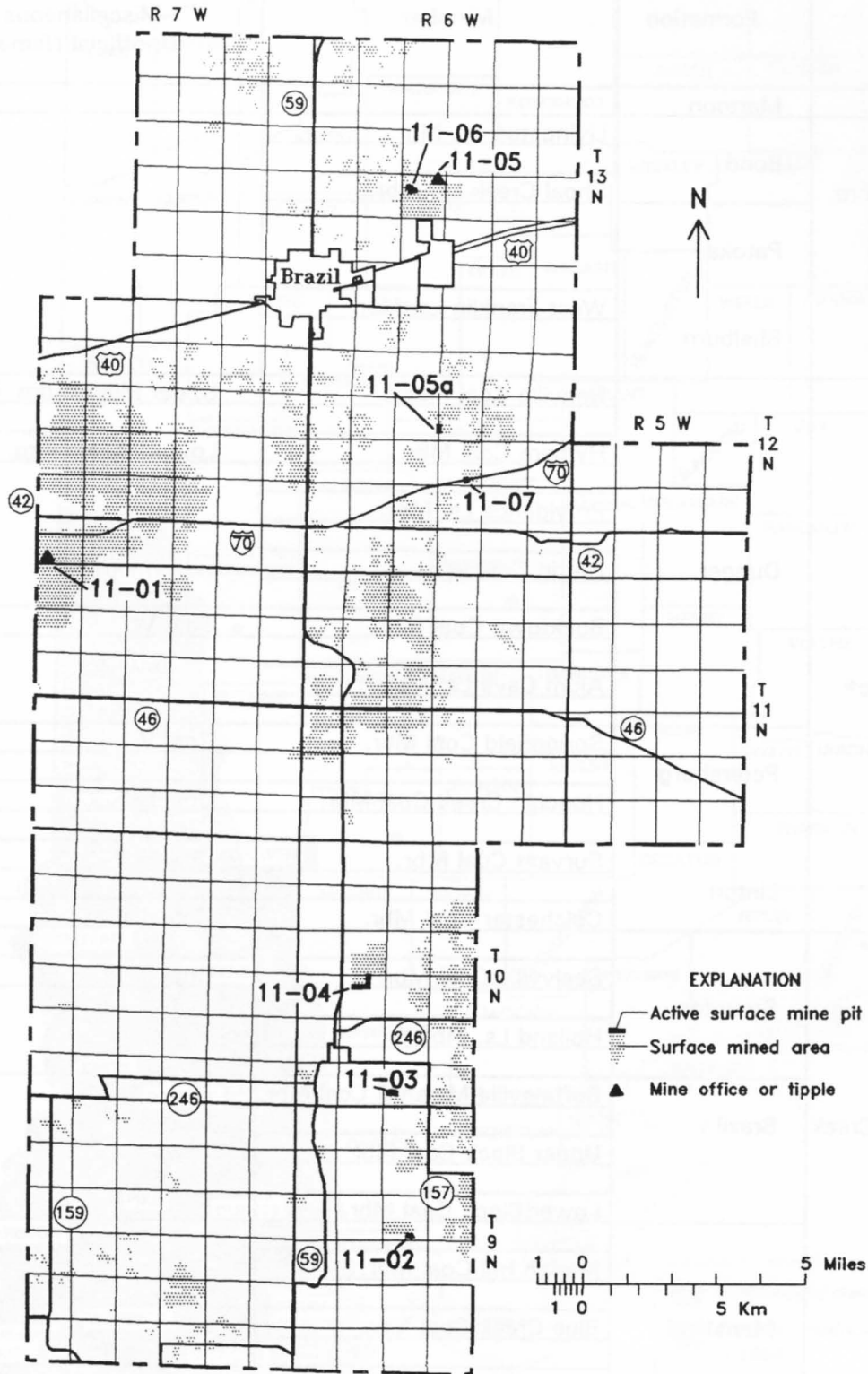

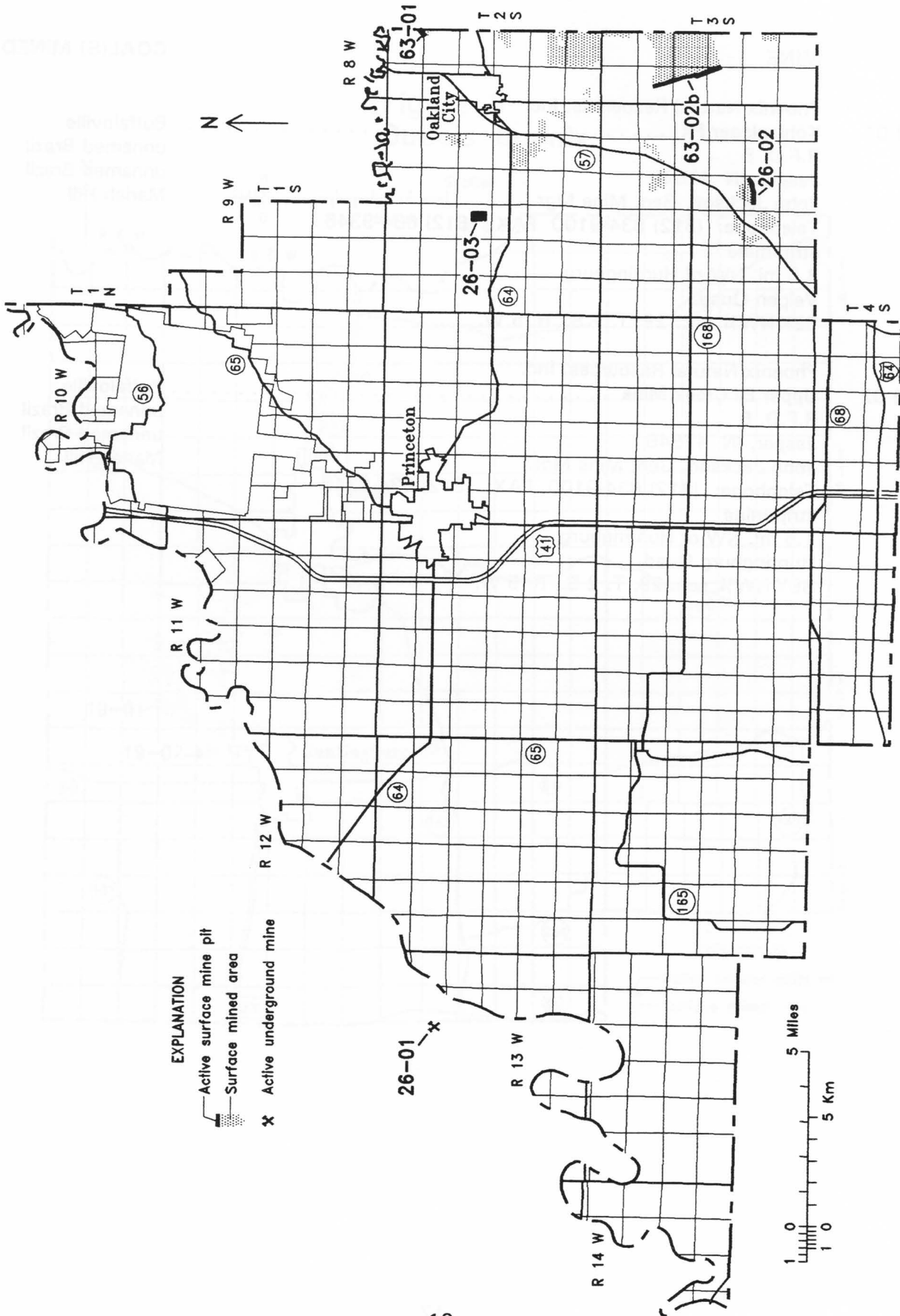

Gibson County



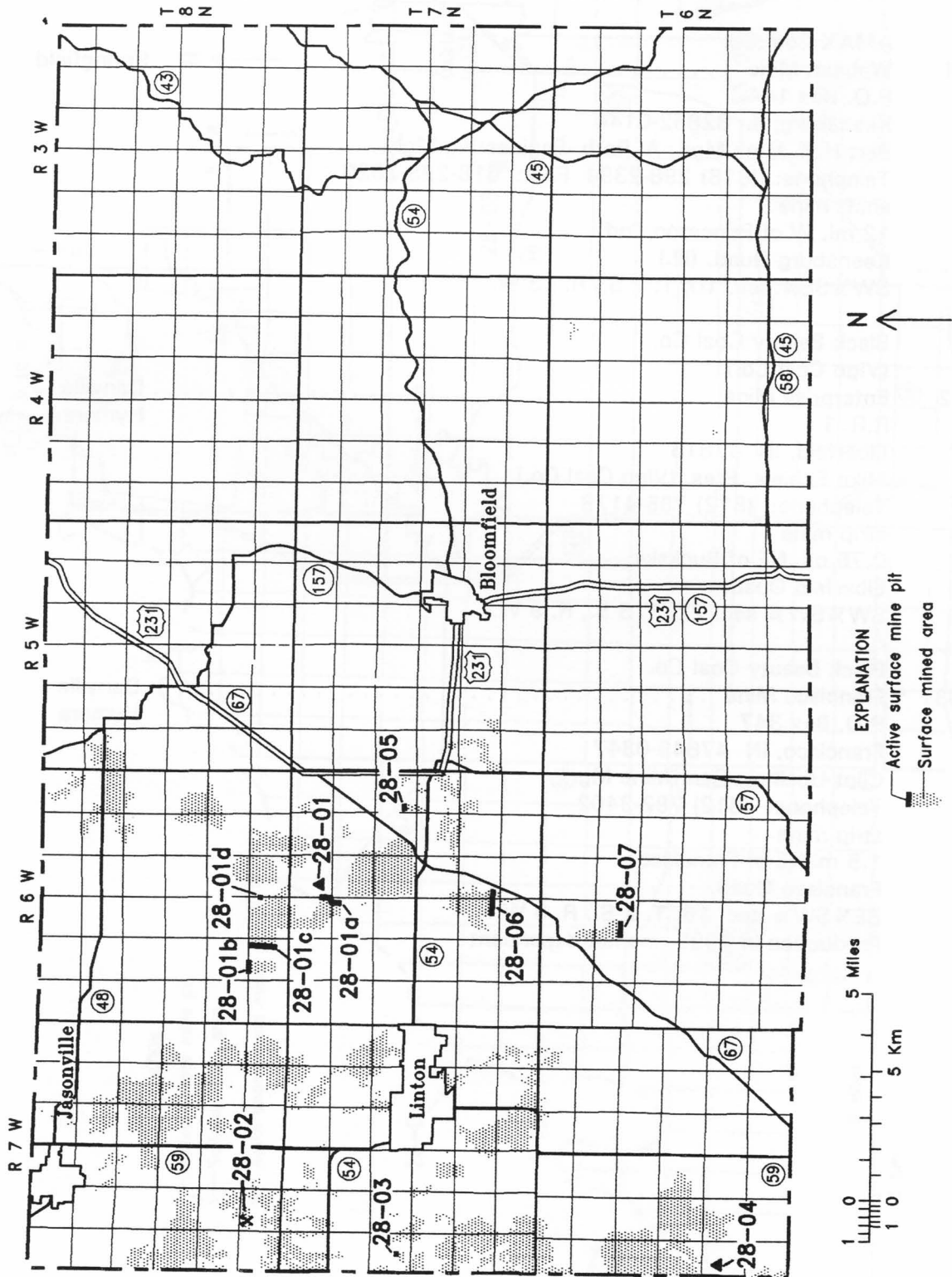
